Book Blast is Coming Soon

All students in grades K-12 are encouraged to participate in Book Blast on Friday, October 31. Students need to wear a costume of their favorite book character to school. This costume must be school appropriate. No weapons are allowed with the costume. Students in the class will guess which character your child has chosen. All students in grades 3-12 will do oral book reports of their character, even if they do not dress up. Students will be graded on their report and character costume. Students who do not dress up must be in school uniform. No thongs for shoes. Classes will decorate a cake as a cover of a class book. Supplies for the cake decorating will be due October 27. Students will eat the cake at the end of the day!

Labeling Student Items and Dress Code
