State Testing/AzMerit/AIMS Science and End of Course for High School

State testing will be April 13– 24. **There will be no tutoring after school during testing weeks.** Please do not schedule appointments during these weeks. Please make sure you have your child at school by 8:00 AM daily so that teachers can start promptly with the testing.

Students who are not absent during testing will get ice cream on Friday, April 24. We need 100% of our students taking the test! Please be sure to mark these dates on your calendar.

Water Day

This free fun event takes place the last day of school for all students in grades K-12. For a student to be eligible your child must complete 80% of their homework, including the reading journal, starting the week of March 23. This is a great event so don't miss out.

School Trips for K-12

Students were notified if they qualify. Students can not be absent more than 3 days as of January 16, complete 90% of homework with reading journals, and not be suspended.

Dress Code Reminders
