Please make sure your child is completing their math homework and reading and writing journals.

Reading has Rewards

Students need to turn in their reading journals for grades K-7 as part of their homework. Please help raise reading test scores by reading with your child nightly. Journals are available in the office. The cost is \$3.00. We will be using these journals for students to qualify for Pizza Hut rewards.

Bus Behavior

The bus is a continuation of the school day. Remind your child that it is a privilege to ride the bus. Students must stay seated and talk quietly. They may do their homework on the bus.

School Trips

Students need to be sure to continue to meet the requirements for school trips.

1. Homework turned in at 90% including their reading and writing journals.
2. Not miss more than 3 days until January 31, if they started the first day of school. No absences for anyone who started after the first day.
3. No school suspensions.
4. Attend all school state testing in the spring.
5. Have a good attitude and be trustworthy.

Drop off and Pick Up

Parents are doing a great job of having students exit and enter the cars quickly. Make sure you drive up to the curb.

Electronic Devices

Students must check in their cell phones daily in the office. CD players, IPods, DS players and other electronic items are not allowed on the bus or at school.

Re-Enrollment Packets

Re-enrollment packets will be sent home on February 16. These are required for every child. These are required to secure a spot for the 2018-2019 school year for every student.

Attendance

As a reminder students ages 6 - 16 must be in school unless excused by a parent. Please call in by 8:30 AM daily if your child is absent.

Checking in at the Front Office

If your child comes to school after 8:00 AM he/she must be checked in the office by an adult.

Conferences

The end of the semester is January 31. If your child is not at grade level a letter will be sent home on February 7 to meet on February 21. A plan will be developed for your child to be promoted. A decision will be made on promotion for your child at the end of the year. Your child must attend the meeting with you. The meetings will take place after school.

ECAP (Education and Career Action Plan)
