Re-enrollment Forms for 2018-2019

As a reminder all re-enrollment forms are due on March 1, 2018 for the 2018-2019 school year. An enrollment form is needed for each child. If you have a neighbor or friend who is not attending Country Gardens and would like to enroll for next year, let them know open enrollment begins March 2. Forms are available in the school office.

State Testing/AzMERIT/AIMS Science and End of Course for High School

State testing will be April 2 –10 for students in grades 3 -11. **There will be no tutoring after school during testing weeks.** Please do not schedule appointments during these weeks. Please make sure you have your child at school by 8:00 AM daily so that teachers can start promptly with the testing. Students who are not absent during testing will get ice cream on Friday, April 13. We need 100% of our students taking the test! Please be sure to mark these dates on your calendar.

Alpha Society Grades 5-High School

Students who pass all AzMERIT and AIMS Science assessments in the spring qualify for Alpha Society. Students must requalify annually.

Grade Enhancement for Grades 9-11

All students in grades 9-11 who take the AzMERIT and/ or AIMS Science assessments can earn one grade higher if they score proficient or highly proficient for AzMERIT or exceeds or meets for AIMS science for each semester grade. Be sure your child tries their best. Students must score highly proficient or exceeds to have their grade changed from a B to an A.

Homework over Spring Break

Please make sure your child is completing their homework and reading nightly over spring break. Students in all grades need to make sure that they are reading nightly. Students in grades 3-11 can go to Arizona Department of Education website and practice the AzMERIT for their grade level in ELA and math. This is good practice.

E-mails for Staff

On the school website are emails for staff. Please check the new email address for your child's teacher. Teachers and staff will respond to your concerns within 24 hours.

Lost and Found

Make sure you label your child's jackets and belongings. We have collected a lot of items. These items will be donated to Goodwill over spring break.

50's, 60's, 70's Dance/Activities
