### WELCOME!

We are glad you chose Country Gardens as the school for your child. If you have any concerns or questions about your child please contact your child's teacher at 623-900- 2230.

### TRUANCY/SCHOOL ATTENDANCE

Any student who is between the ages of six and sixteen must be in school. Truant means a child who has missed school for at least five school days/periods within a school year or exceeds 10% of the school days, which is 18 days for our school. There is a \$50.00 diversion fee if students are cited. If students are cited you will need to report to court with your child. Students who miss 20 days of school will be retained. Please help get your child to school. **Students will receive free ice cream on Fridays if they are not absent all week. Please make medical, dental and other appointments for Wednesday afternoons so students do not miss school. Students who miss more than 20 days may be retained. Call the office by 8:30 AM if your student is absent for the day.**

### PARENTS DRIVING TO SCHOOL

If you are dropping off/picking up students please pull up to the curb and have your child exit or enter the car quickly. This will help with the flow of traffic. Do not go around stopped cars. If you need to leave your vehicle you must park in the designated areas and not on the curb. All kindergarten parents need to park to pick up your child. This is for the safety of all students. If your child arrives after 8:00 AM you must check in the office with your child.

### JOURNALS AND SCHOOL SUPPLIES

Please make sure that your child brings in their school supplies. Students need supplies so that they can complete their class work and homework. The school will be providing reading journals and we will be putting writing prompts in the student's homework. All reading lists will be posted on line so you can see what your child should be reading at home.

### E.E.L.S. PROGRAM

Experiential Education on Land N' Sea (E.E.L.S. Program) is a program available to all students in grades K-12. To qualify for the trips students must meet the following criteria:

1. Have good attendance and not miss more than 3 days for the first 100 days. That is 97% attendance.
2. No school suspensions.
3. Homework turned in at 90%. Including reading journals.
4. Have a good attitude and be trustworthy.
5. Attend all state testing.

### SCHOOL LUNCHESES AND BREAKFAST

Country Gardens does not offer free or reduced prices for lunches. Students in grades K-2 can eat for \$2.00. Older students should bring \$2.00 - \$3.00 depending on their choice of items. Students can not bring soda to school in their lunches. We do not have microwaves to heat up student lunches.

### STUDENT HANDBOOK

Students will be bringing home the copy of the handbook for you to preview and sign. Please have your child return the forms to their classroom teacher to attend zoo lab, barnyard, horsemanship, swimming and use the computers in class. **Due by August 8, 2018.**

### TUTORING

Tutoring will be for students who qualify. Information will be sent home with your child if they need to attend tutoring during the school year. Tutoring will begin on September 4.

Dear Parents/Guardians of Students:

Welcome to Country Gardens! We are glad that you have chosen our school for your child's education. Please do not hesitate to contact your child's teacher (s) if you have any concerns regarding your child. The staff email is listed on our website.

It is very important to take time to review the student handbook with your child. Please be sure that your child is adhering to the dress code in the handbook.

Students may pay \$1.00 to wear a non school shirt Wednesdays all year. This needs to be a t-shirt or shirt that has sleeves. This money is used for the school trips and playground equipment.

The school office is now located in the new building. The office is closed in the log building. Please only call the office for emergencies to relay to students. Inform your child if they should ride the bus or be picked up daily before they come to school. If you do not call the office by 3:00 PM your child will be placed on the bus and by noon for Wednesdays.

As a reminder students **may not use cell phones** on the bus or at school. All students must turn off their cell phones once they enter the bus in the morning. All students must turn in their cell phones during the school day. The phones must remain off during the ride home on the bus. They may turn on their cell phone when they exit the bus. Phones in the office will be used if you need to be contacted. There will be suspensions for students who use their cell phones during school hours and on the bus. Review with your child the importance of turning in their cell phone daily. Students may only bring a cell phone to school if they are in the **4th grade or higher and ride the bus**. Please read the new cell phone policy in the student handbook.

Students will be using computers that are placed in each classroom. Remind your child that he/she must adhere to the appropriate use of technology and return the student handbook pages to use a school computer. If students are using the computers for personal use they will be suspended and will lose their privileges to use the computer for the rest of the year.

For the safety of all students and staff no adults are allowed past the front and middle gates during school hours. We will have these gates open during Open Conferences and special events.

We will be having an Open House on Wednesday, September 19 from 6:00 –8:00 PM to showcase what the students are learning. A Title I Informational Meeting will be in room 6 to discuss the Title I program at Country Gardens on September 19 from 5:15- 6:00 PM. This meeting is open to all parents/guardians.

## **Past Times Café**

As a reminder we do not have a free or reduced lunch program, thus all students must buy or bring their lunch to school daily. Students will be responsible to bring in cash for grades 1-high school if they are buying lunch. Kindergarten students must load money on their card. If students in grades K-3 forget their lunch you will be called.

No outside beverages and food allowed on campus unless the items are in your child's lunch. Students may not bring outside beverages and food on campus in the morning to eat at school. Students are allowed water bottles on campus.

## **Backpacks K-12**

Backpacks may not be larger than 8 1/2 X11 or you will be notified that your child may not use their backpack. You may purchase Country Gardens Charter School draw string bags for \$5.00 in the office.
