TAX CREDIT DONATIONS DEADLINE IS DECEMBER 31, 2021

In Arizona, you can donate up to \$400.00 per married couple to a public school. Single or head of household can donate up to \$200.00. This money will support extracurricular activities such as clubs, your child's field trip, and tutoring. You will be given a tax credit toward your Arizona taxes. Forms are available in the office. You will need to provide the receipt to your accountant. Donations can be made via cash or check at the front office. Thank you for your donations!

ASBESTOS AWARENESS
