K-12 Please label all of your child's notebooks, folders and supplies with their first name, last name and grade. All personal school supplies MUST be kept in their own book bin/binder. The Kleenex, Expo markers, pens and pencils will be collected for use in the classroom, these items do not need to be labeled with your child's name.

Be sure to also label all lunch boxes, jackets, sweaters, towels, swim clothes and any other items that may be brought to school.

LOST AND FOUND: The school collects lost and found on campus and it is placed in bins at the front office. Each quarter any remaining lost and found is discarded.

School supplies are to be brought to school during meet the teacher day. 6th-12th grade students may drop off all supplies listed except their composition books or binders. These must be brought with them on the 1st day of school. BE SURE TO LABEL your students school supplies. K-5 school supplies MAY NOT be left at the front office, it is yours and your child's responsibility to bring them to the teacher at meet the teacher day.
