Subject: Asbestos Awareness and Management Plan (AHERA) 40 CFR Part 763 –
Asbestos – Containing Materials in Schools; Final Rule and Notice, October 30, 1987, 763.84,
Local Education Agency (LEA) responsibilities.

The Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) requires all private and public schools to inspect for asbestos containing materials in school buildings. The AHERA protocol also states that the Local Education Agency (LEA) perform a three- year inspection and provide notification to all parties concerned of any changes or updates. Parent and employee notifications must be made on a yearly basis about inspections, response actions, and post response action activities, including periodic re-inspection and surveillance activities that are planned or in progress at each school K-12 in accordance with AHERA.

Asbestos materials were not identified within the on-site school structures. The EPA requires an asbestos Management Plan (MP). The MP (dated August 25, 2017) is available for review at the administrative office of the school.
