#### STATE TESTING/AASA/AzSCI/ACT

State testing will be in April for Grades 3<sup>rd</sup> – 8th, 9<sup>th</sup>, and 11<sup>th</sup>. Grades 3<sup>rd</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> will be taking the AASA. Grades 5<sup>th</sup>,8<sup>th</sup>, and 11th will be taking the AzSCI. Grade 11 will be taking the ACT and 9th Grade will take the ACTAspire. Our school will be doing computer-based testing for all state tests this year.

- \*April 3-14 AASA grades 3<sup>rd</sup> 8th
- \*April 5th & 12th AzSCI for grades 5th, 8th, and 11th
- \*April 25<sup>th</sup> ACTAspire for **9**<sup>th</sup> **grade**
- \*Grade 11 will be taking the ACT Parts 1 and 2 on March 28.

Please do not schedule appointments during these weeks. Testing starts first thing in the morning so please make sure your children come to school by 8am and that they have had breakfast. Students arriving before 8am can buy small breakfast items at our café. Students who are NOT ABSENT during testing days will receive FREE ice cream from the café once testing is completed. We need 100% of our students taking the test!!

## ALPHA SOCIETY GRADES 4 - HIGH SCHOOL

Students who pass all AASA, AZSCI, and ACTAspire assessments with a proficient or highly proficient will qualify for ALPHA SOCIETY during the next school year. (ALPHA is for 5<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grade) Students must regualify annually.

#### **GRADE ENHANCEMENTS for GRADES 7, 8, & 11.**

All students in grades 7,8, and 11 who take the AASA and or AzSCI can earn one grade higher if they score proficient or highly proficient for AASA or exceeds or meets for AzSCI for final grade (each semester grade for 11th). Be sure your child tries their best. Students must score a highly proficient or exceeds to have a B changed to an A.

# **HOMEWORK OVER SPRING BREAK**

Please make sure your child is completing their homework over the break. Students in all grades need to be reading nightly. This is great practice and a good way to prepare your student for the tests.
